Prayer's Possibilities

What if you knew in the next few days your life would be ended and you were trying to sum up for someone what your life meant, what you felt were the abiding values of your life. What would you say? Here is where we find Jesus in John 17:4-8. Jesus reviews his life to the Father, a review of thirty-three years of ministry on earth. Reading these verses, Jesus appraises his own life.

The first thing he points out to the Father is that he accomplished a work which glorifies.

"I glorified thee on earth, having accomplished the work which thou gavest me to do, and now, Father, glorify thou me in thy own presence with the glory which I had with thee before the world was made." (John 17:4-5)

That work included more than the cross. It encompassed his ministry of healing and mercy which His Father had given him to do.

Then Jesus points out that he revealed God's name.

"I have manifested thy name to the men whom thou gavest me out of the world; thine they were, and thou gavest them to me, and they have kept thy word." (John 17:6)

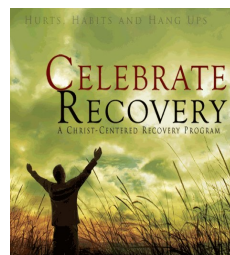
The revealing showed us the total resources of God - a tremendous, unending resource.

The third thing Jesus said that characterized his life was that the disciples believed.

"for I have given them the words which thou gavest me, and they have received them and know in truth that I come from thee; and they have believed that thou didst send me." (John 17:8)

What made these Jewish disciples believe that this man was also Incarnate God, sent of the Father? Was it Jesus' Miracles that convinced them? Was it then the power that he exercised over men? What was it? It was his words! The words of Jesus searched their hearts, and opened their eyes, and dispelled their doubts, and set afire their lives. These words still have that power today.

Pray that God stop us from piddling around in the shallows of Christian living any longer and lead us to lay hold of the mighty, transforming Christian life that Jesus himself manifested.
