ABOUT

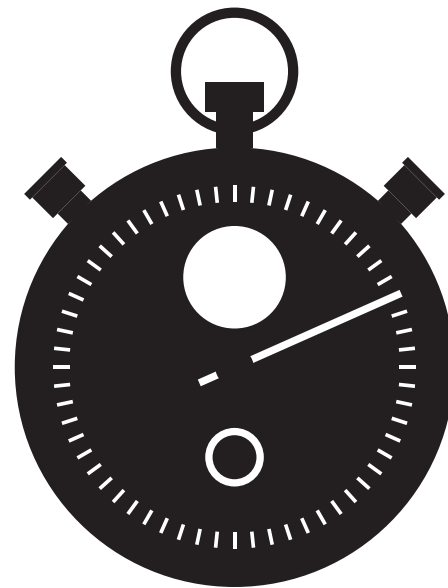
